

Vision statement

Our vision is to support and develop a strong non-profit community of climbers in Aarhus, who contribute to the growth and flourishing of our sport. We want to offer high-quality training facilities that enable skill development across both climbing disciplines and experience.

We want to be a safe and homely space where new and old climbing enthusiasts can gather to learn, share experiences, support and inspire each other across age and seniority.

Our goal is to foster a lifelong passion for climbing while sparring with the international cultural community of climbing and with respect for nature.

Our vision is supported by the following 6 core areas:

Core area 1

Community through social club events and the development of a homely "home-away-from-home" social area that provides coziness, relaxation and a desire to get together.

Core area 2

Pivot point for Aarhus as a powerhouse for climbing sports in Western Denmark, where potentials are cultivated and where open exchange of knowledge, experience, skills and expertise is fostered.

Core area 3

Supply and continuous development of world-class training facilities as well as high wall routes and boulder problems for all bodies and levels.

Core area 4

Active enthusiasm for outdoor climbing and facilitating a local climbing environment that contributes to and reflects the culture of the international climbing community.

Core area 5

Strengthen the community spirit and highlight the collective as well as personal benefits of volunteering. Voluntary work and initiative must be highly valued and balanced in friendly coexistence with the need for continuity and degrees of professionalism within relevant key areas, including safety, operations and management, training and courses as well as route and problem setting.

Core area 6

Association in financial balance, where membership fees and other incomes are for the benefit and joy of all our members in the form of better facilities, better conditions (e.g. accessibility for both members and guests) as well as better community and club spirit.
